Composition- 1,2 and 3
Comparison –'more than' and 'fewer than'
Counting objects to find out 'how many' objects there are altogether.
Compare the number of objects in 2 sets by matching them 1 to 1.

Wider curriculum units:

-Expressive Arts and Design - To manipulate materials to achieve a planned effect.
-Understanding the World/RE - What does 'The Gift of Friendship' story tell Muslim people?
Understanding the World/RE - What Happens at Diwali?
Show interest in different occupations and ways of life. Comment and ask questions about aspects of their familiar world such as the place where they live or the natural world.
-PSED - How do we make friends?
Build confidence to speak to others about own needs, wants, interests and opinions.
Enjoy responsibility of carrying out small tasks.
